



Longcross to Woking directions 8.5 miles / 13.6 km

1. Exit Longcross station (there is only one way out!). In front of you is Longcross film studios. Turn right on the small path between the fence of the film studio and the station and follow the path as it curves to the left and joins a tarmac track.
2. To your right is Chobham Common. Go past a small parking area on the right and at the second parking area turn right past a metal gate onto a wide path straight across the common.
3. Follow this path as it curves to the left, narrows, crosses a wet area on a wooden bridge and emerges at a wide track. Turn right down this track and follow it until you hit another wide track. Turn left and quickly pass through another low metal gate across the B386, then through another metal gate and straight on.
4. Very soon you will come to a foot tunnel under the M3. Continue through the tunnel and follow the path left. This path then curves to the right and continues straight on across Chobham Common. Continue on this path, ignoring side turnings, until it comes out onto a very wide track with woodland ahead.
5. Turn left here, keeping the woodland to your right. The path then goes into the woods. Keep straight on. Soon ahead you will see the high fence of the Longcross Estate. Turn right on the path near the fence and follow this path straight on through woodland, past large rhododendrons and over a long wooden walkway. Eventually the path will turn right with the estate fence ahead of you.

6. Take this path which soon emerges at a road. Cross over and go through the car park opposite (Chobham Common fish pool car park) continuing straight on until you see a fishing pond to your right down a small incline. Follow the edge of the pond around to the right and left turn at the end of the pond, through two sets of wooden posts.
7. After the second set of wooden posts, turn right onto a track and then take the first left so that you're doubling back on yourself but beyond the fishing pond, following a path to Stonehill Road. Turn left on the road and then, at a T junction, cross the road and turn right down a bridleway, signposted 'bridleway link to Youngstroat Lane'.
8. Follow this track straight on through woodland. You may see a long wooden fence to your right. Follow this bridleway until you meet another track and see buildings ahead, then turn right onto a stoney track between fields. This track ends at the busy A319.
9. Cross the road and turn right. On your left there is a sign for Fair Oaks Airport and a public bridleway sign.
10. Take this left turn and follow it with the airfield on your left. After a while you will cross a wooden bridge over a stream. Keep straight on here.
11. You will then reach the woodland of Horsell Common. Continue straight on until you reach a wide path. Turn left along the path passing a large pond to your right and then another pond (or marshy area depending on weather) and a large sandpit.
12. Keep straight on until you come to some houses and a cross track called "Anthony's". Turn right here and follow the track for a short distance until it meets Chertsey Road.
13. Cross the road and turn right. Immediately after the Hotel Sands (now closed), turn left off the road onto a track. Follow this path round to the right with a fence to your left. Keep on this path as it passes All Saints Church to your right and crosses the A245 (roundabout to your right).
14. Carry straight on to the other side of the road with houses to your left until you see an alleyway to your left. Take the alleyway and follow the path through fir trees until you see the clearing to your right with the walled Peace Garden in the middle.
15. The Peace Garden is open to all to look around.
16. Continue straight on to the main road (Monument Road) and turn left here, crossing the bridge over the Basingstoke Canal.
17. Immediately after the bridge, follow the sign to the left down to the canal towpath.

18. Turn left under the bridge you have just crossed and follow the canal for about 1 mile into Woking. Pass under the first road bridge over the canal and, at the second bridge, turn up the ramp to street level.
19. Turn left and cross the large main road (Victoria Way) and ahead you should see the large metallic War of the Worlds sculpture on a wide pedestrian walkway. Continue straight onto Chobham Road. Woking station is on the right at the end of the road.
